

TRI-COUNTY TECHNICAL COLLEGE FOUNDATION 2010-2011 Fall-Spring General Scholarship Application

Through the efforts of Tri-County Technical College's Foundation and the extreme generosity of private donors, the College will be able to award numerous scholarships for the 2010-2011 Fall/Spring academic year. All curriculum students who plan to enroll in at least six credit hours are eligible to apply for these scholarships. Demonstrated academic ability and other donor stipulated criteria, as well as financial need, are considered in the selection process. **You must be enrolled in a certificate, diploma, or Associate Degree program and be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours.**

Scholarship award amounts vary and may not represent total tuition costs. Proceeds must be used for the payment of tuition or other college-billed expenses, including books. **Students will not receive a check from the Tri-County Technical College Foundation for any monies remaining from their scholarship, but the funds may be used the following semester within the academic year (August 2010-July 2011).**

The deadline for submitting a completed application to the Financial Aid Office is Thursday, March 25, 2010. All applications received by mail should be postmarked by Wednesday, March 24, 2010. Late applications will NOT be accepted. All scholarship recipients will be notified by Friday, April 23, 2010.

Please make sure to read and complete the entire application. If you do not have a current Tri-County transcript, you must attach your most recent college or high school transcript. Applications without proper documents will not be considered.

All applications will be considered for those scholarships for which the eligibility criteria is "Any student." If you meet the eligibility criteria for any other scholarships, please put an "X" in the "Eligible to Apply" column and you will be considered for that scholarship. **Students are only eligible for one Foundation scholarship per academic year and must reapply each year.**
