



Dear Graduate

Thank you again for submitting your application for graduation. As the semester comes to a close, final grades and GPA calculations will be posted on Monday, July 29, 2024. On this day, we will conduct a final review of graduation applications to confirm that you have indeed met all graduation requirements. This includes: * successful completion of any courses that were in progress for this term *all applicable transfer credit was received if you were using credit from another college to help satisfy some of your requirements *you are meeting the minimum 2.0 program GPA requirement * you have satisfied all financial commitments to the College. The purpose of this letter is to inform you about graduation requirements and the graduation ceremony.

Graduation Requirements

Candidates who do not have at least a GPA of 2.00 or better in their program of study or who have not completed all course requirements by the end of summer 2024 will not be permitted to graduate. Candidates who have completed all academic requirements but have not satisfied all of their financial commitments to the College will not be permitted to graduate.

Commencement Ceremony

The summer 2024 commencement ceremony will take place Monday, August 5, 6 p.m., at Littlejohn Coliseum, located at 219 Perimeter Road on Clemson University's campus. Graduates must arrive by 5 p.m. in order to participate in the ceremony. Graduates will enter by the loading dock on the Avenue of Champions. Graduates may pick-up their printed credentials on Tuesday, August 6 from 9 am - 4 pm or Wednesday, August 7 from 9 am to 4 pm in the Ruby Hicks Building at the Pendleton Campus. If you choose to not pick-up your credential(s), they will be mailed to you the week of August 12th to the address printed on this letter.

What to Wear

Graduates are encouraged to dress for this event as they would for a wedding or other semi-formal event. If you plan to wear pants, consider dark pants and shoes. If you plan to wear heels, consider a low heel. A bow tie or standard dress tie with a white dress shirt is appropriate. Dark dresses or dress suits, dark skirts or trousers and a blouse are also appropriate. Suit jackets are not required. No jeans or sneakers please.

Accommodations

If you or your guest(s) have mobility issues and need accommodations for the commencement ceremony, please notify the Registrar's Office/Student Data Center via email at graduation@tctc.edu.

Tickets

Tickets are not required. The commencement ceremony will be live streamed for those who cannot attend in person. A link to the live stream can be found on our website: tctc.edu/gradlinks.

Parking

Graduates and their guests must park in C-3, which is located at the corner of Perimeter Road and Avenue of the Champions. Signage will be posted indicating where to park. A parking map can be found on our website: tctc.edu/gradlinks.

Note: If you are graduating in your declared major and you plan to continue your studies at TCTC, you must meet with a Success Coach prior to the last day of classes for the summer 2024 semester in order to continue enrollment. Success Coaches are located on the first floor of Ruby Hicks Hall on the Pendleton Campus.
