Nursing Competitive Clinical Entry Application Fall/Spring Entry Criteria and Instructions

Deadline Dates:

Fall Entry: May 15th to May 31st

Spring Entry: September 15th to September 30th

Note to students: The following steps are needed in order to submit your Competitive Clinical Entry Application:

1. Go to MyTCTC → Academic Resources tile
2. Find your Nursing Clinical Entry Application. Review the information. Section B-1 below
3. Submit your Nursing Clinical Entry Application electronically (Required for eligibility: Pre-Nursing Workshop, minimum TEAS scores, minimum ATI RN Fundamentals scores, GPA, and BIO 101 Section A-4 below)

Section A: Application Checklist

1. View the Online Pre-Nursing Workshop
2. Check your application for credentials, courses and correct grades showing. See Section B-1 below
3. For guidelines on TEAS scores, ATI RN Fundamentals Nursing Test, GPA requirement and General Education courses required, go to the form called Steps to Transition – Practical to Associate Degree Nursing at <https://www.tctc.edu/nursing>
4. LPN license must be a current and unencumbered Multi state license
5. LPN Nursing Education must be from a nationally (ACEN) credentialed college/program
6. Paramedics require an Associate in Applied Science Degree

Section B: Instructions for submission

1. You are responsible for the accuracy of the information found on the Nursing Clinical Entry Application as it relates to points earned. If you find errors or incomplete information about your **transfer credits or grades**, you must submit your request for review or change to the Registrar's Office at registrar@tctc.edu one week prior to the application deadline. If your question is about **degrees from other colleges not showing**, contact Admissions at (864) 646-1550 one week prior to the application deadline. All CNA certifications must have been processed one week prior to application deadline.
2. TEAS score transfers must have been received one business day prior to application deadline.

3. Submit your electronic copy of the application online from May 15th to May 31st or September 15th to September 30th.
 - A confirmation email will be sent to the students TCTC account once the application has been submitted correctly. Email Bailey Woods wwoods@tctc.edu for any questions or concerns related to your application submission. You should receive an email notice of acceptance or denial approximately three weeks after application deadline to your Tri-County email.
