

Personal Voice Amplifier Instructions

TCTC IT has personal voice amplifiers, equipped a wireless microphone, available to faculty to augment instruction.



Try It Out

Getting Started

The wireless microphone comes pre-paired with the amplifier. Simply rotate the volume knob to turn on the amplifier. There is an “ON/OFF” switch on the side of the microphone headset.

Volume Control

Adjust device volume by rotating the volume knob on the device. You can also adjust the volume by pressing “+” or “-” on the wireless microphone

Troubleshooting

- Power has been turned on, but the amplifier has no sound:
 1. If the LCD is not lit, the unit may need charging.
 2. Turn up the volume on both the unit and the microphone.
- The amplifier has no sound when using the wireless microphone:
 1. Confirm both device and microphone are powered on.
 2. Confirm the proper pairing. Pair again if necessary.

- The amplifier has feedback:
 1. Make sure the microphone is not too close to the amplifier.
 2. You may need to turn volume down to avoid feedback.

Charging Instructions

Wireless Microphone:

When the microphone's blue light flashes, the battery is low. Turn the unit off and charge using the provided charging cord. A red indicator light will appear when charging and will turn off when the microphone is fully charged.

Notes:

- Normal charge time is to 5 hours.
- Fully charge before first use of microphone for best results.
- Turn off the UHF microphone when not in use.

Amplifier:

When the battery icon flashes, the unit needs recharging. A charging cable is provided. The battery icon will flash during charging and will stop flashing when fully charged.

Note:

- Fully charge the amplifier before first use.
