This Amendment is issued to provide clarification on the specifications requested under section III. Scope of Work/Specifications page 11.

Additional Specifications:

- 1) At least 10,000 lb. capacity but not greater than 11,000 lbs.
- 2) Engine must meet standard specs for roadway use and run on LP Gas only.
- 3) Transmission must be automatic and must have power steering.
- 4) Fork length must be at least 60” but no more than 65” side shifting pallet forks
- 5) Headlights with guards or work lights with guards
- 6) Back-up alarm and seat belt.
- 7) High visibility mast
- 8) Full suspension adjustable seat
- 9) Separate break and inching pedals
- 10) Amber strobe light mounted below OHG.
- 11) Rear view mirror or mirrors mounted inside the guard system.
- 12) Tires are to be used in both warehouse and driven on roadway with speed bumps.
- 13) Fire extinguisher, UL approved LP Tank, Hour Meter.
