



Establishing In-County Residency

Tuition at Tri-County Technical College is determined by the student's county of residence.

If your permanent address is changing to Anderson, Oconee, or Pickens County and you wish to be considered for in-county tuition, a copy of your lease agreement or closing document must be provided. To qualify, you must have been domiciled in Anderson, Oconee, or Pickens County continuously for at least twelve months immediately preceding the first day of class of the term for which resident classification is sought.

In order to affect tuition for the current term, this process must be completed by the last day of drop for Session A. Residency changes after this deadline will apply to the subsequent semester.

If your permanent address is changing to "in-state," a Residency Application Packet must also be submitted to the Residency Officer.

Students who falsify residential information will be charged at the appropriate tuition rate, plus interest at a rate of eight percent per annum, plus a penalty amounting to twenty-five percent of the out-of-state rate for one semester.
