Rights of Catalog

AU Bridge students receive rights to the AU catalog in effect as of the date of full-time enrollment at AU.

Formal Admission

Students who complete an Associate of Art (A.A.), Associate of Science (A.S.), Associate Degree in Nursing (A.D.N.), or Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) in Business or Criminal Justice degree program at Tri-County will be guaranteed admission to AU upon successfully completing all steps for AU enrollment. Students who earn a minimum 2.5 grade point average (GPA) and 30 transferable, non-developmental credits (with earned grades of C or above) may transfer prior to earning an associate degree at Tri-County and will be guaranteed admission to AU. Students may have additional admissions requirements to be admitted to specific degree programs.

Students are required to complete the AU admissions application at least thirty (30) days prior to the beginning of the AU academic term they wish to attend. The AU application fee will be waived as part of the AU Bridge Program. Official transcripts from all previously attended colleges beyond Tri-County and any official AP/IB score reports must be submitted directly to AU's Office of Admissions as part of the application process.

Transfer Credit

The transfer of coursework from Tri-County to AU is seamless for AU Bridge Program students – all transferable, non-developmental credits (with earned grades of C or above) completed at Tri-County will transfer as either general education, major, or general elective courses. While admissions is guaranteed, courses will be evaluated for applicability to the intended AU major/degree program.

Participation Agreement

I certify that all information provided in this agreement is complete and accurate and I understand that withholding or falsifying information on this agreement is cause for cancellation of enrollment at AU. I am responsible for contacting Tri-County Admissions for further instructions for admission to that college.
