Communication & Literature: Complete 9 credit hours from the list of approved courses satisfying the requirement. You must have one course from SPC 200 or SPC 205.		Electives: Complete at least 16 credit hours of approved elective courses. Courses to be chosen by the student under guidance of the faculty advisor and in coordination with major roadmap. Specific courses are excluded from consideration. See First Year notes.	
Mathematics or Natural Sciences: Complete at least 23 credits from the list of approved math and science courses. You must have at least 6 credits of math courses and 8 credits of natural science courses with lab.		Humanities and Social Sciences: Complete 12 credit hours from the list of approved courses satisfying the humanities and social sciences general education requirement. You must have at least 3 credit hours from humanities and 3 credit hours from social science.

Note 1: All first semester courses have specific entry requirements. All Math and Science tracks require a minimum of C or better to advance in the series. Consult the catalog for prerequisites and/or placement scores.

Note 2: BIO 102 should be taken by students looking to concentrate in Cardiovascular Leadership or Pre-Professional Health. BIO 240 should be taken by students looking to concentrate in Health Promotion.

Note 3: Students who do not meet MAT 130 placement requirements should consider taking the required MATH pre-requisite course here and delay CHM 110 until semester 2.

Note 4: For students transferring to institutions in SC, the Reach Act recommend HIS 201 or PSC 201. Students planning to transfer to an institution outside of SC may opt to take an elective instead. Please consult catalog requirements and your faculty advisor when selecting appropriate ELECTIVE courses.

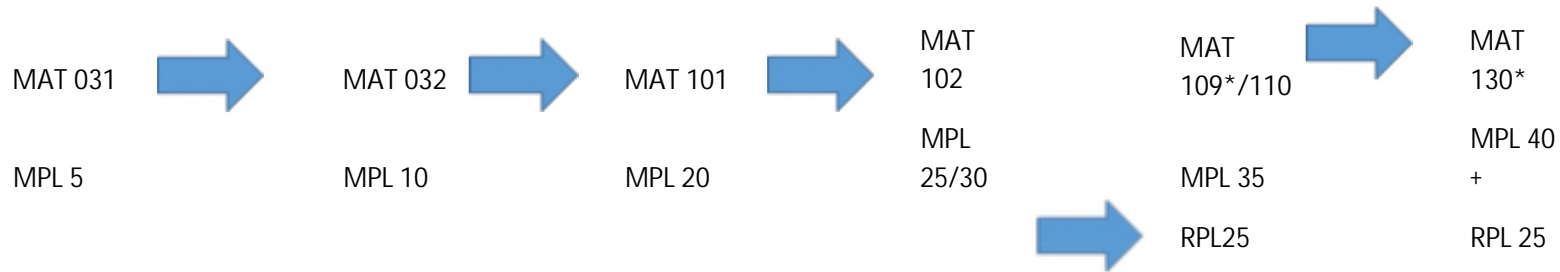
Note 5: PHY 202 should be taken by students looking to concentrate in Pre-Professional Health. Other concentrations may take an elective here.
