Tri-County Technical College is seeking quotes Truck Driver Training Simulator with motion for our Truck Driver Training Program. The simulator must be all inclusive and contain all required items to be fully functional. The simulator must, at a minimum, meet the description/specifications listed below.

- On board full simulation of a wide variety of heavy vehicles from dump trucks to highway tractor-trailer applications to include both CDL A and CDL B modules.
- Options for both automatic and manual transmissions with realistic force feedback and vibrations on the shifter with various modules to master the manual transmission gear pattern.
- Modules to allow for realistic student training with backing skills.
- High-performance, three-axis motion system that continually provides motion/vibration integration into the cabin.
- Fully functional pneumatic driver seat with all typical controls.
- Realistic responses with the clutch, accelerator, and brake pedals based on actual vehicle measurements including realistic anti-braking system response.
- Software ability to change environments from rural, urban, to freeway along with ability to change climate conditions from day, night, snow, and rain.
- Software ability to program problems and malfunctions with both the truck and trailer.
- Provide Student Training Assessments to track student progress with real time feedback along with printable reports.
- Included on-site set-up and delivery with on-site training for the staff.
- Provide minimum of 1 year of technical support, maintenance, and software updates with full 1-year warranty at no cost to the College with on-site support.
- Provide cost to College for additional/optional 3 years of warranty coverage as a separate line item from the main quote total.
- Provide 3 references for simulator operation and warranty support.

(a) The State shall pay the Contractor, after the submission of proper invoices or vouchers, the prices stipulated in this contract for supplies delivered and accepted or services rendered and accepted, less any deductions provided in this contract. Unless otherwise specified herein, including the purchase order, payment shall not be made on partial deliveries accepted by the Government.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision, payment shall be made in accordance with S.C. Code Section 11-35-45 which provides the Contractor's exclusive means of recovering any type of interest from the Owner. Contractor waives imposition of an interest penalty unless the invoice submitted specifies that the late penalty is applicable. Except as set forth in this paragraph, the State shall not be liable for the payment of interest on any debt or claim arising out of or related to this contract for any reason.

PROTESTS (MAY 2019)

If you are aggrieved in connection with the solicitation or award of the contract, you may be entitled to protest, but only as provided in Section 11-35-4210. To protest a solicitation, you must submit a protest within fifteen days of the date the applicable solicitation document is issued. To protest an award, you must (i) submit notice of your intent to protest within seven business days of the date the award notice is posted, and (ii) submit your actual protest within fifteen days of the date the award notice is posted. Days are calculated as provided in Section 11-35-310(13). Both protests and notices of intent to protest must be in writing and must be received by the appropriate Chief Procurement Officer within the time provided. See clause entitled "Protest-CPO". The grounds of the protest and the relief requested must be set forth with enough particularity to give notice of the issues to be decided. [02-2A085-2]
