Phlebotomists are specialized clinical support assistants who collect blood and other samples from patients for examination in laboratories, the results of which provide valuable information for diagnosing illness. Duties include the collection and preparation of specimens; maintenance of collection areas, equipment and supplies; performance of record-keeping duties.

Entry & Clinical Requirements

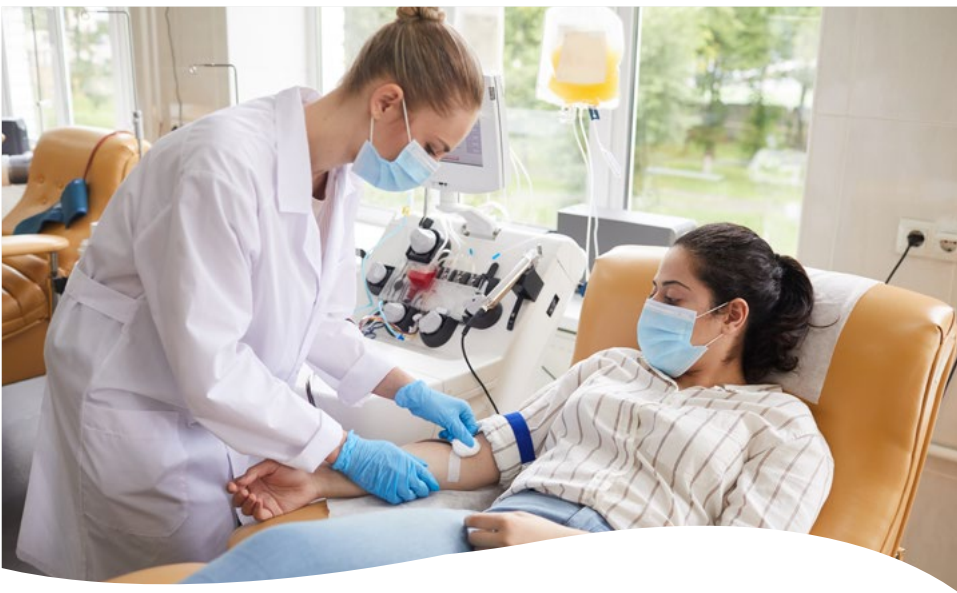
- Picture ID (ex. Driver's License)
- Health Care Application
- A High School Diploma or GED
- National Background Check, such as SR&I or PreCheck
- 10-Panel Drug Screen
- Flu Shot
- Proof of 2 MMR Immunizations or Titer
- Proof of 2 Varicella-Zoster (Chicken Pox) Immunizations or Titer
- Proof of 3 Hepatitis B Immunizations OR Signed Declination Form
- 2 PPD (TB) 2-step Skin Tests (4 Total steps)- 3 months before clinical
- Tdap Immunization within past 10 years
- COVID-19 Vaccine

Program Details

- Our 160-hour program includes 100 hours of clinicals and lasts approximately four months.
