

# MAPPING THE JOURNEY *Enrollment Checklist*

## *Access the TCTC Bridge Portal*

- Log in using the instructions sent to your Clemson application email.
- Complete and submit all required supplemental information in the portal.
- Be sure to save your TCTC Bridge portal link after creating your account.
  - If you forget it, you can always sign in at **[www.tctc.edu/btcportal](http://www.tctc.edu/btcportal)**
- **Remember:** You will have two portals —your Clemson Bridge portal and your TCTC Bridge portal. Each portal is used for different steps, so be sure to check both regularly for updates and instructions.

## *Credit Review for 18+ Earned Hours*

- If you have 18 or more earned credit hours (combined dual enrollment, AP, or IB), send in an unofficial transcript to **[bridgetoclemson@tctc.edu](mailto:bridgetoclemson@tctc.edu)**.
  - Your credits will be reviewed to help determine whether the Bridge to Clemson Program is the best academic fit for you.

## *Submit Your Non-Refundable Deposit*

- Once all required information is complete, submit the \$200 non-refundable deposit through the TCTC Bridge Portal.
  - Follow the payment instructions provided in the portal.
- **Deadline: May 1, 2026, by 11:59 p.m. EST.**

## *Receive Your Official Acceptance Letter*

- After submitting your deposit, you will receive an official Bridge to Clemson acceptance letter from TCTC in mid-March along with your Orientation Guide.

## *Complete Clemson University Authentication*

- Follow the onboarding steps in your Clemson Bridge Portal to set up your Clemson username and password.
  - This process activates your Clemson email.
- You must complete this step before accessing Clemson Housing and Dining.
  - Allow several business days for processing before attempting to log in to the housing and dining portal.

## *Complete the 2026-2027 FAFSA*

- Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by **May 1, 2026** for federal and state aid consideration.
- Be sure to include the **TCTC school code: 004926.**
