Anderson School District 5 Scholarship assists with material fees and digital course content fees after all tuition cost are covered.

For example, a student in Anderson School District 5 taking English 101 and MAT 120 would have a credit of \$130 after LTA funding, TCTC scholarship, and A5 scholarship are applied to student's tuition balance. That credit would be applied to the student's account to cover material fees and digital course content fees. Costs will vary depending on the number of hours taken, courses requested, and digital course content fees/materials fees associated with course cost.

Funding Details:

- ☑ Funding will be applied to all AOP University Transfer student accounts.
- ☑ Funding for TCP Pathway students will remain at 100% including all tuition and textbooks/materials.
- ☑ For students whose permanent addresses are outside of Anderson, Oconee, or Pickens County, out-of-county tuition increases may apply. TCTC will evaluate additional supports for those students.
- ☑ TCTC Scholarship funding will be applied up to 9 credit hours. TCTC scholarship funding will not be applied to any credit hours over the 9-hour scholarship maximum; however, students will still receive Lottery Tuition Assistance on all credit hours taken over six credit hours in the same semester. Students will be responsible for remaining balance.
- ☑ TCTC Scholarships will replace Free and Reduced Lunch scholarships. Additional funding for students with extenuating circumstance may be available on a case-by-case basis.
- ☑ TCTC funding will appear on student's bill as a TCTC scholarship.
- ☑ Program fees are based on credit hours taken and will be applied to student accounts; they are outlined here and not factored into the Net Total Tuition cost listed above:
 - 12+ credits = \$40
 - 9-11 credits = \$30
 - 6-8 credits = \$20
 - Less than 6 credits = \$10
- ☑ Additional material fees and digital course content fees will be applied to student accounts and are not factored into the Net Total Tuition cost listed above. Those fees for applicable coursework will be included in the final bill. Digital course content fees cover the cost of the access to digital textbooks or course specific learning software to minimize the need for separate textbook purchases. Digital course content fee ranges from \$40-\$120. English 101 digital course content fees are around \$40, while Biology and Math digital course content fees are around \$120.
